CHECKLIST

- What is your character's goal in this scene?
- How does this scene drive the plot?
- How does this scene show 'character'?
- What is the dramatic conflict in this scene?
- Does the scene have a clear dramatic arc?
- How does your character(s) feel at the start of the scene?
- Does the chronology of this scene make sense?
- Is the setting clear? How does the setting add to the scene?
- What is the mood of the scene? How can you make this more prominent?
- How does this scene demonstrate the theme of your story?
- How have you used the senses to bring this scene to life?
